## Therapist

### Position Description

Humanitri is a faith-based not-for-profit organization with roots in the Lutheran community. Our mission is to help families facing homelessness achieve stability in a safe and supportive community, providing the skills and resources they need to thrive. Humanitri is hiring a full-time Therapist for our Transformational Housing Program, which provides housing support, resource referral, skill building, case management, and mental health support to primarily single mothers as they work toward increased self-sufficiency.

The Therapist will conduct comprehensive intake assessments and develop client-centered service plans for a caseload of 20 clients. The Therapist is responsible for providing weekly home- and office-based individual and family counseling for 6-9 months, or a period sufficient to achieve measurable progress on goals. The Therapist works as a partner with Humanitri's Family Support Specialists to ensure that clinical and case management efforts align to support clients in their goals. In addition, the Therapist provides monthly psychoeducation groups for heads-of-households to address common challenges and build essential skills.

Candidate must have dependable transportation; be willing and able to travel to and work in client homes; and be available to work occasional evenings and weekends. Counselor must engage comfortably and confidently with Humanitri's client population.

### Skills:

- Knowledgeable of the needs and risks associated with homelessness, domestic violence, and poverty
- Knowledgeable of community resources and supports available to clients
- Knowledgeable of HIPPA regulations and best practices related to confidentiality in communication and documentation
- Ability to work as a member of an inter-disciplinary support/care team with providers within and outside Humanitri
- Ability to provide solution-focused, strengths-based, and empowering services to multi-stressed families
- Ability to maintain clinical focus and manage client relationships during clients' crises
- Knowledge of trauma-informed practices and motivational interviewing preferred
- Skilled in building and maintaining a network of collaborative community resources
- Ability to communicate clearly and professionally with clients, colleagues and stakeholders verbally and in writing

### Qualifications:

- Education: MSW or MA
- Credentials: Fully Licensed LCSW or LPC (Missouri)
- Experience: 3+ years' experience required. Experience working with homeless families preferred
- Computer Proficiency: Microsoft Office, Web Applications
- Interpersonal and written communication. Ability to communicate with clients, colleagues and stakeholders
- Organized, detailed-oriented with ability to multi-task
- Able to and willing to work 1-2 evenings per week, as needed, to accommodate clients' work schedules
- Able and willing to work one Saturday per month to lead psychoeducation groups
